### **Notice Regarding Termination of Operations at Sogo Hachioji**

At a meeting of the Board of Directors held on February 23, 2011, Sogo & Seibu Co., Ltd., a consolidated subsidiary of Seven & i Holdings Co., Ltd., resolved to terminate operations at Sogo Hachioji.

The details are provided below:

#### 1. Reason for Termination of Store Operations

In the Seven & i Group's department store operations, Sogo & Seibu is taking steps to strengthen its business and management foundation as well as to enhance its asset efficiency. As a part of those initiatives, Sogo & Seibu has determined that it would be difficult to achieve a recovery in the store's performance stably in the future, and made the decision to close Sogo Hachioji.
